Student Accident Insurance

Student accident insurance is included in your child's registration fee. The insurance covers an incident that may occur while your child is on campus on a school day and while on school events such as camp outs and field trips. Parents may also purchase additional insurance for full-time, sickness, dental, and pharmacy. The school's insurance is secondary to your personal insurance. It will cover your deductibles, and extra medical expenses. If there is an incident you will need to get a form from the school office.

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SECURITY

We take your child’s safety very seriously. As a precaution, we keep school doors locked during the day. To enter the building, go to the main door near the office and be “buzzed” in. Make sure that Mrs. Long sees your face in order to be allowed in. You only need to push the door bell if Mrs. Long is not in her office.

When Long pushes the button at her desk, you will hear a click when the door unlocks. When you hear the click you may enter. As soon as Mrs. Long releases the button, the door locks again, so don’t delay!

PRE-PLANNED ABSENCES

We have documents that need to be completed and turned in prior to any absences. There is a form for grades PK-6, and a form for grades 7-12. Please complete the form as early as possible (days or weeks in advance) so that the teacher can be prepared and recognize when a student will be missing an important educational moment. The forms need to be signed off by the teacher prior to drop off at the school office. You will find the forms in a wall pockets outside the school office.
