PK-4 Pants/skirt of choice and SAA shirt

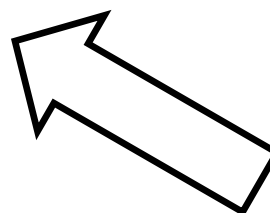

UNIFORM DRESS CODE—LEGGINGS

The dress code is specific about what is appropriate for tights, socks and leggings. On page 7 of the Handbook you will find the following pertaining to uniforms:

Additional Guidelines

- Only solid colored belts in navy blue, black, or brown are allowed.
- **Only solid-colored tights, socks, or leggings in SAA uniform colors of navy blue, teal, beige, white, and black.**
- Only uniform white or navy camis or tank tops may be worn under shirts.
- Skirts, skorts, and jumper hems must meet length criteria – even if student is wearing leggings/tight pants/nylons/tights under it.
- All uniforms and non-uniforms (PE, Free Dress Day, Spirit Wear, and Special Theme Days) must comply with length/modesty requirements.



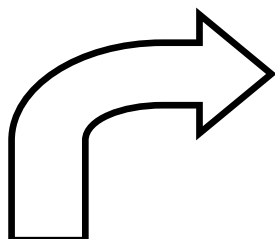
7/8 MOUNTAIN SCHOOL
